

CRUCCI) Hippie Hanks Beanie

MEASUREMENTS

To fit head circumference approx. 56cms

MATERIALS

1 x Hippie Hanks 100g hank (colour 41 Teal pictured) 1 pair 12mm (US 17) needles or size to give the correct tension Wool needle

Pom Pom maker (optional)

TENSION

8 sts and 12 rows to 10cm over blocked stocking stitch, using 12mm needles.

BEANIE

Using 12mm needles, cast on 38sts.

1st row – K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to end.

2nd row – P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows once.

Work in stocking stitch until work measures 15cms from beg, ending with a purl row.

Begin Shaping -

1st row – K1, *K2tog, K7, rep from * to last st, K1. 34 sts 2nd row – P1, *P6, P2tog, rep from * to last st, P1. 30 sts. 3rd row – K1, *K2tog, K5, rep from * to last st, K1. 26 sts. 4th row – P1, *P4, P2tog, rep from * to last st, P1. 22 sts. 5th row – K1, *K2tog, K3, rep from * to last st, K1. 18 sts. 6th row – P1, *P2, P2tog, rep from * to last st, P1. 14 sts.

7th row – K1, *K2tog, K1, rep from * to last st, K1. 10 sts.

Cut the yarn and thread the end through rem sts.

Draw tightly and fasten securely.

TO MAKE UP

Join the side edges to make the back seam. Weave in ends

If desired, make pom pom and attach to the crown of the beanie using remaining yarn.
